Student Athlete Code Of Conduct

Holy Family embodies the discipline of teamwork. It challenges players towards perfection of physical skills and brings into play the excitement of tactics and strategy. With this in mind, Holy Family requires each student athlete, respective parent, and coach to adhere to the following:

1. I am responsible for my actions at all Holy Family events and understand that the student code of conduct is in effect while at any school event.
 - a. I will conduct myself with sportsmanship and maturity at all times during Holy Family events.
2. Student Athletes, parents, and coaches are responsible for representing Holy Family's mission vision and values throughout the season.
3. I will maintain control of my emotions, actions, and language. Any gestures that may be interpreted as hostile or humiliating will not be tolerated.
4. I will respect the coaches, players, and spectators of all teams before, during and after game...win or loss.
5. I will adhere to the sideline rules of the Holy Family designated Head and Assistant Coaches.
 - a. No more than 2 (two) coaches on a team during the game. These coaches must be compliant with Holy Family and have approval by the Athletic Department. No other persons are to occupy the sidelines (parents, siblings, etc...)
 - b. ALL COACHES during game must wear Holy Family appointed shirt. (must be visible)
6. I will not commit any physically violent actions toward anyone at Holy Family sanctioned events.
7. I will provide a sports environment that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol.
8. I recognize that the referee(s) are the sole judge(s) on the field or court. Their decision is final.

9. I will place the emotional and physical well being of the players ahead of a personal desire to win.
10. I will not disrupt the flow of the game and stay with my respective team unless an emergency situation arises.
11. I am responsible for:
 - a. Attending practices and games and the consequences for missing scheduled practices and games.
 - b. Notification to coach if I will not be attending a scheduled practice or game. (24 hour prior notification is preferred if possible)
 - c. Showing respect to my coaches and teammates.
 - d. Adherence to communication policy as developed by coach.
 - e. My own personal belongings. (Coaches will not be responsible for any lost items.)
 - f. Reviewing and signing this code of conduct.

The Athletic Department will support all coaches' actions. However, coaches are responsible for setting up guidelines for team procedures.

I have read and understand the statements in the Student Athlete Code Of Conduct and agree to conduct myself in a manner that demonstrates the established standards outlined in this document. I was also in attendance at the meeting at which the Code Of Conduct was reviewed.
