The EPA Asbestos-Containing Materials in Schools Rule (40 CFR 763, Subpart E) requires the following:

40 CFR 763.84(c) requires the General Local Educational Agency to:

Ensure that workers and building occupants, or their legal guardians, are informed at least once each school year about inspections, response actions, and post-response action activities, including periodic re-inspection and surveillance activities that are planned or in progress.

To comply with this requirement and ensure you that we strive to maintain the highest levels of safety for your children and our staff, we have described below recent compliance activities that have taken place in our school within the past three years, as well as those planned for the next three years.

1. On June 10, 2022 Mr. McCreary completed our six month periodic surveillance of our school.
2. On December 21, 2021 a periodic surveillance of our school was completed by our designated person (Scott McCreary).
3. On July 29, 2021 we had our EPA Required Three Year Asbestos Re-inspection completed by Matt Fergus from HZW Environmental Consultants.
4. Regular periodic surveillances will be conducted to ensure that we maintain a very safe environment and to document changes which could affect the condition of any material throughout our school.

No response actions have taken place within the past year, since the completion of our last three year reinspection on July 29, 2021.

This letter has been composed and delivered to you to inform you of our ongoing efforts to maintain the health, safety and welfare of your children as one of our top priorities and to comply with Section 40 CFR 763.93 of the EPA Asbestos in Schools Rule.
